

## **RULES AND CRITERIA FOR SELECTION PROCESS**

- A. The SCSSC has established a Hall of Fame to recognize those outstanding teams, athletes and supports that have made the organization great.
- B. Forms for the Hall of Fame nominations will be available by request or online at [www.scseniorgames.com](http://www.scseniorgames.com) by November 15.
- C. Nominees shall be submitted to the SCSSC Hall of Fame Committee before January 15.
- D. The selection committee shall consist of a Chairman to serve a four (4) year term; Board members, sponsors, etc. to be determined by the chairman.
- E. Inductions shall be awarded at the CELEBRATION OF ATHLETES of the SCSSC State Games. A reception will follow the ceremony.
- F. Nominations will be held for a period of four (4) years.
- G. Selectees shall be inducted every two (2) years.
- H. The candidates shall have participated in the SCSSC State Games for minimum of 10 years.
- I. A special category for coaches, sponsors, leaders, organizations, etc. who have contributed to the vision of the SCSSC and its mission.
- J. Recipients shall be given a choice of the following awards: A Ring, a Broach or a Plaque. Special category recipients and those accepting for posthumous recipients will receive a Plaque.
- K. Criteria to be considered during the selection:
  - 1. Multiple medal winners on the state and/or national level
  - 2. State record holders
  - 3. Year round performance achievers
  - 4. Outstanding contributors on the local, state or national level toward the cause of senior health
  - 5. Continous supporter of the SCSSC and its goals
